Buying a new car is likely to be one of the most expensive purchases you will ever make, second only to your home. It is therefore essential that you are fully prepared for this event and aware of different options and potential problems. Below are some important tips for preparing to buy your new car.

Set a budget this must be realistic. Do not be tempted to make the budget fit the car. Include the cost of insurance, fuel and servicing etc. Decide how you are going to pay a car loan, finance through a dealership, full payment etc. Decide what you want be sure to consider what you need in a car. Is it to travel long distances, transport children or just for you.

Check the internet to get an idea of current prices, makes and models. Because you can do some tricky stuff now with dealer websites, like move the car in a 360 degree angle, change the colour to see what it looks like before hand and even see it go around a track. Make up a list of cars that are suitable (fit within budget and needs). Take the time to browse around different dealerships asking salespeople for prices and deals. They are there to be badged.

Although expensive a new car offers reliability, with warranties covering any repairs needed for a set amount of time after purchase, check time and details of these with dealers and compare them with others. Test drive all cars on the list consider comfort, handling, parking and even colour (you may have the car for quite a long time).

Test drive for at least 10 to 15 minutes on a variety of surfaces to give an idea of handling. Also do a tight 3 point turn to test for any knocking. Decide on 2 to 3 cars and write a list of good and bad points about each one. Including any deals that have been met etc, & were they are.

Pick one car and go back to various dealerships & ask them what their best price for the car is.

Remember not to but impulsively, if you are getting fraught then go home and try again the next day.

Be prepared to haggle with dealers ask them what they will include for the price (audio equipment, mats, tank of fuel). You are about to spend a lot of money with them, so they are likely to want to come to a deal. Take one last look at the deals on offer and decide.

You may also wish to investigate the safety and reliability of your chosen vehicle before you buy. There are a number of internet sites that offer ratings on safety aspects of cars. These are written by consumers as well as independent motoring organisations and cover crashworthiness, safety and reliability.

- Are seams where doors and fenders meet even and straight?
- Are seams where the hood and trunk meet the fenders even and straight?
- Does a magnet cling to all steel body panels? (Be sure to test fenders, the lower corners of doors, and rocker panels—the areas below doors. If a magnet doesn't cling, suspect body filler was used to repair rust or accident damage.)
- Are all body panels the same color?
- Has the car been recently repainted? (Look for signs of spray paint on moldings; also check the edges of the doors, hood, and trunk to be sure they are all the same color. Fresh paint may cover rust that will continue to progress.)

Tires

- Do all tires have the same amount of tread?
- Are all tires the same size? (Check tire size markings on tire sidewalls.)
- Are all tires the same brand?
- Is there a spare tire, jack, and lug wrench? If the vehicle has locking hubcaps, is there a key for removing them?
- Is the spare tire inflated (Press hard against the side with your thumb; the tire should be firm.)

- Does the vehicle sit level?
- Bounce each corner of the vehicle. Do all corners respond the same? (Corners should only bounce once or twice before stopping.)

- Look underneath each side of the vehicle for a row of holes in the frame just inside the vehicle's outer edge. Do holes appear scratched or recently cleaned? (If so, suspect the frame has been straightened after a crash.)

What Fees Should You Pay?

You skillfully negotiate the price of your new car and you think you're getting a darned good deal. But when you see the contract, with all the additional fees, you go into a state of shock. Where'd all this stuff come from? Are these fees legit? Or is the dealer inflating costs to try to take back profit?

Edmunds.com has created a chart with all the basic car-buying fees. In addition, we show how sales tax on trade-ins and rebates is handled (both differ from state to state). More about this later.

Most commonly, there are three categories of car-buying fees: vehicle registration fees, sales tax and a document fee or "doc fee."

- **Vehicle registration fees:** This is the amount charged by the state to register the new car, assign a title (legal proof of ownership) and cover the cost of license plates.
- **Sales tax:** Sales tax on a new car amounts to more than most people expect. At 8 percent, sales tax on a \$20,000 car will cost you \$1,600.
- **Doc fees:** In states where doc fees are not regulated by the government a dealership will often sell a car at a very attractive price but then hit the buyer with a \$399 doc fee when the contract is drawn up.
- **Taxing the trade-in:** In many states, if you trade in your old car you can get a nice tax break.
- **Taxing rebates:** Increasingly, consumers use cash rebates from car manufacturers to offset the price of new cars.
- **Other Car-Buying Fees:** There are two other aspects of car-buying fees which frequently arise that car buyers should know about.

Dealer fees: Dealers can write other fees into the contract and give them official sounding names: "S&H" or "Dealer Prep" or even "Shipping."

- **Advertising fees:** If an advertising fee is listed *on the car's invoice* we consider it a legitimate fee that should be paid. However, if the advertising fee is *written into the buying contract* by the dealer it is another example of a dealer trying to pass along his expense to the buyer.

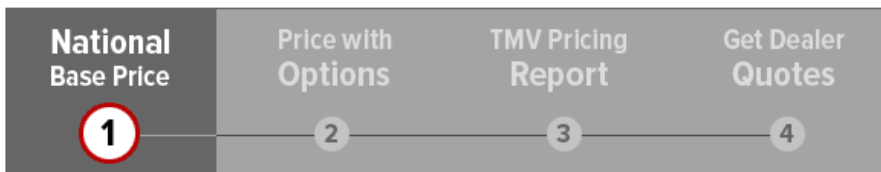

Power corrupts, and absolute power corrupts... well... absolutely. After a week with the Jeep Grand Cherokee SRT8, the most powerful Jeep ever produced, we confess: we've been corrupted. After the first day with the super-powerful SUV, we felt a little dishonest like maybe we could cheat on our taxes or steal a few grapes from the produce section. By the end of the week, the corruption reached a fever pitch. We felt ready to take over as dictator of an oil-rich, third-world nation, or maybe even as CEO of an energy trading firm.

Each of the two previous generations of the Grand Cherokee has offered a go-fast version. The ZJ (1993 – 1998) offered the 5.9L Limited version with a 245 HP 5.9L V8, and the WJ (1999 – 2004) offered the Overland model with a High Output 4.7L belting out 265HP. Even the current generation WK offers a 330HP HEMI version.



But 330HP is commonplace these days, so Jeep needed to do something more if they wanted to produce a vehicle that made a statement. To create one of the worlds fastest SUV's, Jeep started with a run-of-the-mill Grand Cherokee. All-new in 2005, the WK features edge looks, a crisp new interior and a rock-solid chassis.

To prepare it for supersonic speeds, DaimlerChrysler's Street and Racing Technology (SRT) skunkworks team started at the bottom by lowering the ride a full inch, adding four-piston Brembo brakes at all four corners, and installing a new, beefier transfer case to handle the extra muscle.

Inside, the SRT8 gets special gauges with blue surrounds, along with special seats that sport suede inserts and massive bolsters to hold you in place while you explore its exceptionally high cornering limits. You also get a steering wheel wrapped in leather that is made to look like carbon fiber. Otherwise, there isn't much to distinguish the SRT8
